6.1 Personal Digital Device Acceptable Use Policy (AP)

The policy was discussed at the May 14 Board meeting. The new wording is like the old policy, with enforcement dependent on teachers. Personal digital devices are prohibited during instructional time unless approved by the teacher. An Individualized Education Program (IEP) is required for personal use of devices. The policy has been updated per Ministry requirements. Some districts previously had no policy. Teachers should not be put in a position to confiscate devices but some have systems to collect devices at the door. High school students are more independent in managing their devices. The policy will be presented for approval at the Board meeting on June 18.
